

AD SPECIFICATIONS

CREATING AND SUBMITTING YOUR AD

• TRIM size: the final cut page size.

LIVE area: Place text and important images (headshots, products, etc.) .5" from trim edge (preferred), or a minimum of. 375" **BLEED:** Add .25" beyond trim for bleed ads (background images should extend out into bleed area.)

- Please note: always include a jpg proof of your ad for reference in addition to the high res pdf. This will ensure that we are able to check that the placed ad will print as intended.




AD LAYOUT: Full page ads are printed with a full bleed FILE TYPES: Press-ready high resolution PDF

ABOUT BLEEDS, CROPS AND CROP OFFSET

Add .25" beyond document for bleed ads (background images should extend out into bleed area,) and crop marks need a .25" offset. Please add crop marks to all ads, including non-bleed ads and ads with white backgrounds. Please refer to pdf export specs below.





Crop marks extend into bleed area, and may be visible in final print.

Notice that the crop marks are farther apart & do not extend into the bleed area.
